Tokyo, Japan, June 1, 2011: TOMY Company, Ltd. (President, Kantaro Tomiyama), announces the re-launch of its original girls mini-doll brand, *Koeda-chan*¹, with a new design and concept. The centerpiece item of the re-launched line up will be the character's familiar tree house, *Koeda-chan No Ki No O-uchi*² (SRP JPY 6,090, incl. 5% sales tax). Other products will include individual mini-figures, furniture accessory sets, etc. with an initial release of 12 items going on sale July 28, wherever toys are sold nationwide. In addition, TOMY intends to introduce a variety of licensed products and content based on the *Koeda-chan* brand.

Koeda-chan was first launched in 1977 along with the product which has become the hallmark of the brand, *Koeda-chan To Ki No O-uchi*. The brand has since seen several renewals and dormant periods but the nature theme and the unique, cute design and universe, the popular tree house and gimmicks and popular characters have been loved by two generations of young girls age three to six.

For this revival, the nature theme will remain, but the brand will be further strengthened through the following:

- 1. The characters of the *Koeda-chan* world have been re-designed by famed Tatsunoko Productions designer, Suzuka Yoshida and include many new characters including new family members and friends.
- 2. The *Koeda-chan* universe is now a "world of little fairies" filled with many regions to explore such as the "Land of Trees" where Koeda-chan lives and "Sky City," "Sweets City," etc. With many themes to work with, there will be many exciting and imaginative characters and stories.

The new *Koeda-chan No Ki No O-uchi* tree house is a 30cm tall doll house with many fun gimmicks. It starts out as a simple tree, but with the press of a switch at the base of the tree trunk, the green canopy of the tree opens up automatically, transforming the tree into a three-story tree house with an elevator going up through the trunk. With the turn of a knob on top, the elevator goes up or down, carrying passengers from the first to the second floor. There are also other play features such as a swing, a ladder and a slide. TOMY also will offer a wide variety of additional products such as character mini-dolls, furniture sets and accessories, creating a fascinating *Koeda-chan* world which will be fun for both play and for collection.

Girl Rock Duo, PUFFY, Become "Singing Fairies"

The superstar pop/rock duo Ami Onuki and Yumi Yoshimura, who are known collectively as PUFFY³, are self-proclaimed "huge fans" of *Koeda-chan*. The duo is celebrating its 15^{th} anniversary this year, but also has another milestone to celebrate: The two will also get their own characters in the world of *Koeda-chan*! They are already famous for their music, fashion, and entertaining performances both in Japan and internationally and they are also symbolic of Japan's *kawai* (cute) culture. Now they get a chance to expand their presence by becoming the "singing fairies" "*Ami-chan*" and "*Yumi-chan*" in the imaginary world of *Koeda-chan*! They even contributed their own ideas to the design of their characters, which have *Ami-chan* in the motif of a rabbit while *Yumi-chan* has a cat motif. They plan to use these *kawai* characters as part of their upcoming concert performances as well! In the fall of this year, mini-doll characters *Ami-chan* and *Yumi-chan* will be launched as part of the *Koeda-chan* and her other friends.

Morinaga's Koeda Gets its Own "Chocolate Fairy"

Snack giant, Morinaga Company's long-selling twig-shaped snack, *Koeda*, not only bears the same name as *Koeda-chan*, but will now get its own character in the toy series. The snack brand, which features chocolate, almond and crispy puffs, celebrates its 40th anniversary in 2011 (six years older than *Koeda-chan*), is the inspiration for a "chocolate fairy" character named *Koeda-kun*⁴ with a head in the shape of an almond and clothes decorated with "puff" like polka dots. *Koeda-chan* and *Koeda-kun* will appear together in various promotional campaigns.

The books will feature nature themes and sweet, fun stories along with lovely illustrations which will make them a joy for parents to read along with their children.
